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### Abstract

How to take lyophilized PCR primers and dilute and aliquot into useful quantities and concentrations.

## Dilute primers to 100 µM

- 1 Add the volume of nuclease-free water to each tube according to the documentation provided by the primer.

In the case of *E. coli* K12, the following volumes are to be used:

Oligo	Volume
F184031	552 µL
R18551	728 µL

## Make 100 µL stock

- 2 Use the following table to make 25 µM, 100 µL stocks:

Component	Volume
100 µM F184031	25 µL
100 µM R18551	25 µL
Nuclease Free Water	50 µL
<b>Total</b>	<b>100 µL</b>

Making 100 µL aliquots with 25µM of each primer.

- 3 Store all primer mixtures in freezer for up to 2 years

## Aliquot primer mixtures

- 4 Aliquot the primer mixture into quantities that can be expected to be used in one day to avoid freeze/thaw cycling.
