INCLUSION CRITERIA

- Tissue donors participating the Brain and Body Donation Program at Banner Sun Health Research Institute
- Tissue donors 19 years of age or older

EXCLUSION CRITERIA

- Tissue donors under the age of 19 years
- Tissue donors with hepatitis B or C, tuberculosis, syphilis, HIV-AIDS, Creutzfeldt-Jakob disease or other prion or viral encephalopathies (infectious or highly contagious brain diseases)
