- 3 **Open Education:** The work must be in compliance with United Nations (UN) Education Science Culture Organization (UNESCO) 'Open Science' and 'Recommendation on Open Educational Resources' and incetives the promotion of open access publishing inclusivity and accessibility.

European Union Public License (EUPL)

- 4 **Rule of Law (RoL) Interoperability:** This license allows the downstream interoperable merging of multiple licenses, or not, through the European Union Public License (EUPL) to facilitate its compatibility and reuse in open source and open educational resource (OER) development.

Ethical Sources (ES)

- 5 **Do No Harm:** Uses of the work must comply with the Ethical Source Hippocratic License 3.0, which requires no use to cause any harm to individuals or communities.
- 6 **Justice Equity Diversity Inclusion (JEDI) Code of Conduct:** All contributors must agree to abide by the Contributor Covenant Code of Conduct to maintain an inclusive, respectful, and harassment-free community.



Creative Commons (CC)
