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Aligning Science Across Parkinson's

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Abstract

Parkinson's Disease (PD) is a neurodegenerative disorder often preceded by gastrointestinal dysfunction. Mutations in leucine-rich repeat kinase 2 (*LRRK2*) are known risk factors for both PD and inflammatory bowel disease (IBD), suggesting a link between PD and the gastrointestinal tract. Using single cell RNA-sequencing and spectral flow cytometry, we demonstrated that the *LRRK2* Gly2019Ser (G2019S) mutation is associated with an increased neutrophil presence in the colonic lamina propria during *Citrobacter rodentium* infection. This concurred with a Th17 skewing, upregulated *Il17-a*, and greater colonic pathology during infection. *In vitro* experiments showed enhanced kinase-dependent neutrophil chemotaxis and neutrophil extracellular trap (NET) formation in *LRRK2* G2019S mice compared to wild-type counterparts. Our results add to the understanding of *LRRK2*-driven immune cell dysregulation and its contribution to PD, offering insights into potential biomarkers for early diagnosis and intervention in PD.
